PROGRAM PURPOSE

Perform imparts young people with the tools and skills required to meet future employers' expectations in the workplace and build confidence for their post-secondary school transition.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

Ongoing consultation with industry partners underpins the development of this intensive one-day program. Trained industry mentors guide participants through a series of structured learning modules, focused on motivating participants and working closely with them to develop key skills and attributes necessary for a successful post-secondary school transition into the world of work, further education or training. Personal participation of trained industry mentors in program deliveries give participants a practical and real-world perspective.
