MYROAD IS BACK FOR 2017/18

EQUIP YOUR STUDENTS WITH 21ST CENTURY SKILLS

Beacon is currently taking bookings from schools to host MyRoad sessions between 1 August 2017 (Term 3) and mid-April 2018 (end of Term 1).

MyRoad's unique online / virtual delivery means we can connect trained industry mentors from any location to regional, rural or metropolitan classrooms across the country! MyRoad mentors will come from a diverse range of occupations and will reflect cultural and gender diversity.

Through a two-hour interactive video session, mentors will engage with female secondary school students aged 16 to 19 (or turning 16 that year) using questioning and enquiry techniques to maximise student engagement around key themes. With a focus on building knowledge and understanding of the 21st Century skills needed in a rapidly changing world of work, MyRoad is also aligned to 'General Capabilities' and 'Work Studies' in the Australian Curriculum.
