Program Purpose

Prepare introduces students to the world of work and gives them an insight into prospective careers and work readiness skills.

The program is designed to motivate young people to achieve positive outcomes in the classroom and their daily lives, setting personal goals in a highly aspirational environment while demonstrating relevance to the curriculum.

Program Outline

Prepare is delivered by a high energy, professional Beacon Facilitator. During the space of a school day, 20 - 25 students participate in interactive workshops focused on developing team work, life skills, goal setting, growth mindset and self-belief.

Students are introduced to the world of work and given an insight the varied paths that can lead to a rewarding career. The value of education as an enabler as well as the value of networking are key messages within the program content.

Prepare sets the foundation skills around work readiness to be built on in Polish and Perform.
